Mr. Earlywine stated the purpose of this public hearing was to levy master special assessments. The bond validation was scheduled for April 12, 2021 and bond funds would be issued approximately 30 days thereafter. Special assessments were declared at the last meeting at which the Master Engineer's Report and the Master Special Assessment Methodology Reports were presented and approved.

Mr. Adams stated there were no material changes to either Report.

Mr. Earlywine discussed the findings of the Reports, including that the proposed project benefits the lands within the District, there is sufficient benefit to justify the level of assessments and the assessments, as presented in the Reports, are fairly and reasonably allocated, consistent with the assessment roll attached to the Methodology Report.
