#### **RESOLUTION 2021-33**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE STONEWATER COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT APPROVING A PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021/2022 AND SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING THEREON PURSUANT TO FLORIDA LAW; ADDRESSING TRANSMITTAL, POSTING AND PUBLICATION REQUIREMENTS; ADDRESSING SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**SECTION 5.** Notice of this public hearing shall be published in the manner prescribed in Florida law.

**SECTION 6.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
